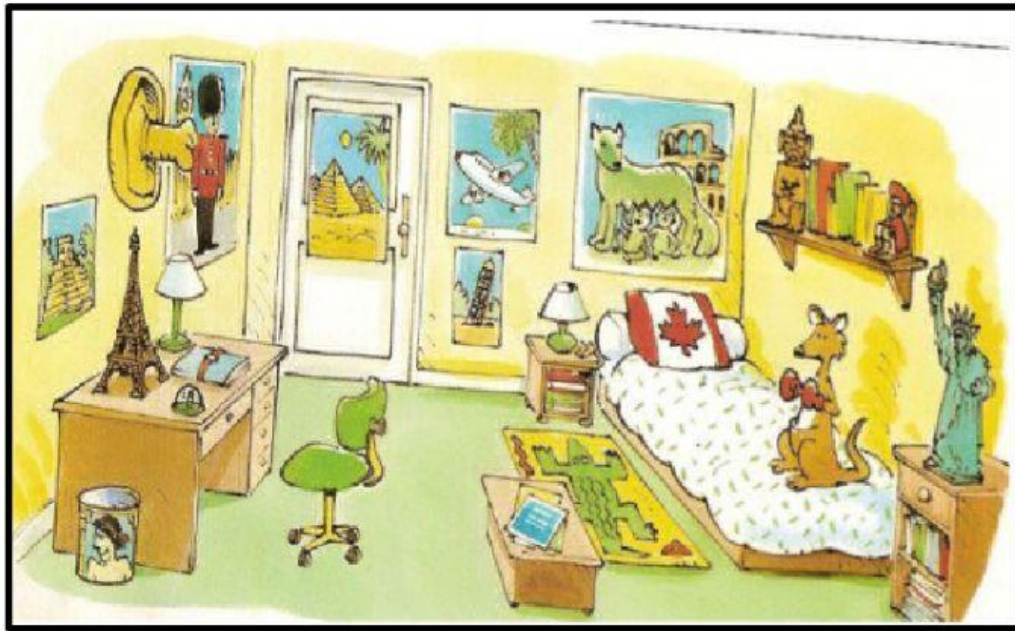


Where has he been ? What have they done ?
