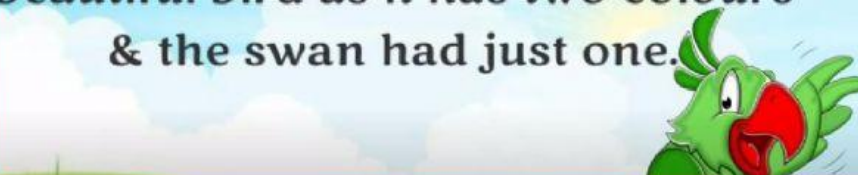
The crow expressed his thoughts to the swan.
