

Potatoes



Potatoes came to us from Central and Southern America. When Spaniards came to America, they wondered that Indian tribes ate strange things like apples. Sailors brought them to Europe in the 16th century. First people tried to eat potatoes rare: they made salads of potato leaves but nobody liked the dishes. And people forgot potatoes.

Francis Drake, a well-known English sailor and traveler brought potatoes to Europe again at the end of the 16th century. In many European countries people tried to use potatoes again. In France, rich people liked white potato flowers, in Germany rich people liked the smell of potato flowers, in Poland people thought potatoes were herbs.

But poor people liked potatoes best of all. They called potatoes the second bread. In German town of Offenburg, there is a monument to Francis Drake with the following writing: "To Sir Francis Drake who spread potatoes in Europe 1580."

Some people in many countries like potatoes very much and cook many dishes of it. There are many sorts of potatoes in the world. In Ukraine, we prefer pink potatoes; in Germany and Poland, people prefer yellow potatoes. In England and the USA people like white potatoes. People do not only eat potatoes.


