

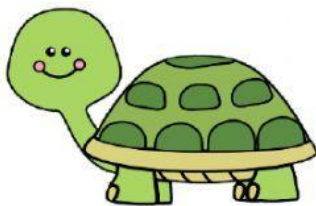
Written Composition
