1. For instance, when thousands of tourists go to see gorillas in Africa, the animals' natural habitats are damaged.
2. Finally, a huge volume of tourists create the need for development.
3. First of all, ecotourism interferes with animals.
4. Ecotourism is bad for the environment because it bothers animals, it damages natural places, and it encourages development of natural areas.
5. For example, turtles in Costa Rica are having problems laying their eggs because of all the people who watch them on the beach.
6. Damage to natural areas, animals, and over-development are negative side-effects of ecotourism.
7. Secondly, ecotourism doesn't preserve natural places; it damages them.
8. For example, tourists need somewhere to sleep and eat, so facilities such as hotels and restaurants must be built in the natural areas.
9. Another example is some animals are no longer afraid of people, so they become too tame and often attack people for food, and then the animals must be killed.
10. Similarly, coastal areas near beaches are often over-developed with condos and hotels for people who want to enjoy the ocean life.
11. Also, even if tour operators try to keep the area clean, thousands of people create a huge amount of garbage.
