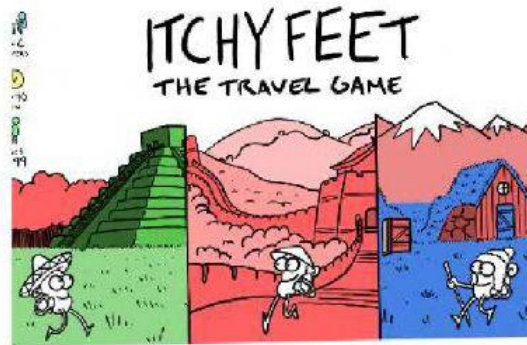


This week article is about idiomatic expression
