

CAN - CAN'T

My dog can run very fast, but it can't swim.



MUST = HAVE TO (HAS TO)

You must hit the ball and run to play baseball. = You have to hit the ball and run to play baseball.



MUSTN'T

You mustn't kick other players when you play basketball.



DON'T/DOESN'T HAVE TO

You don't have to wear white clothes to play tennis.

He doesn't have to wear white clothes to play tennis.
