

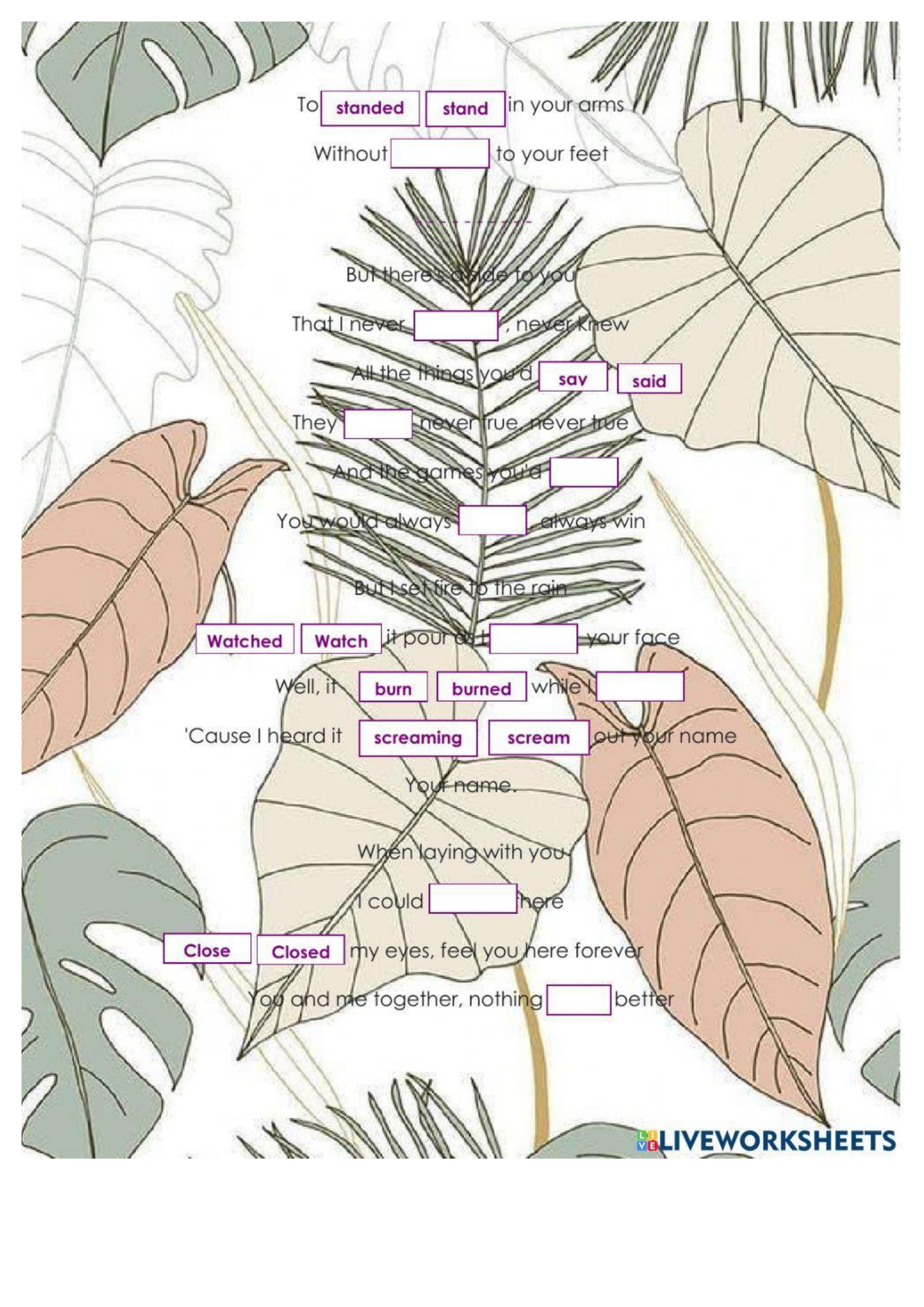
Set Fire to The Rain

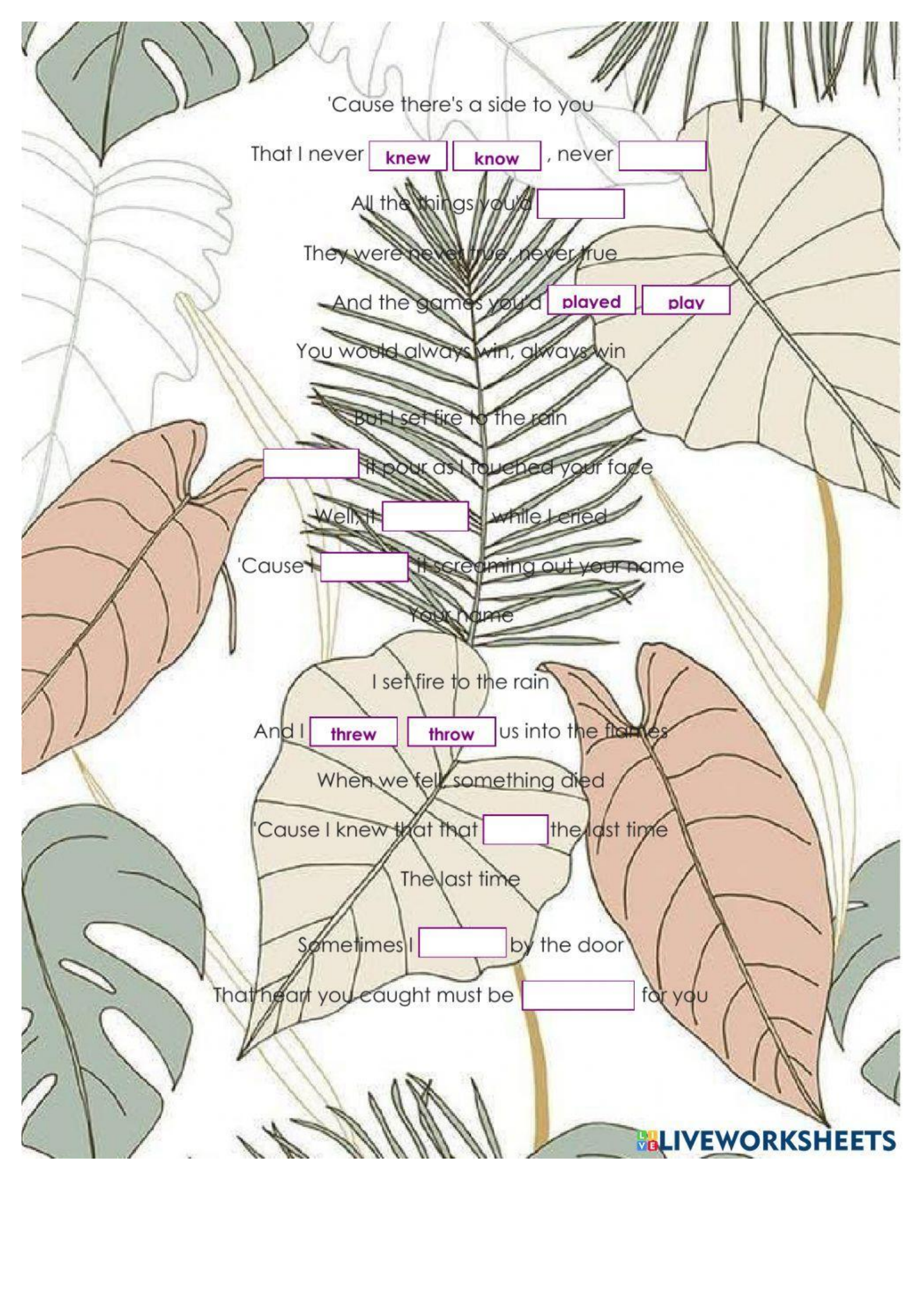

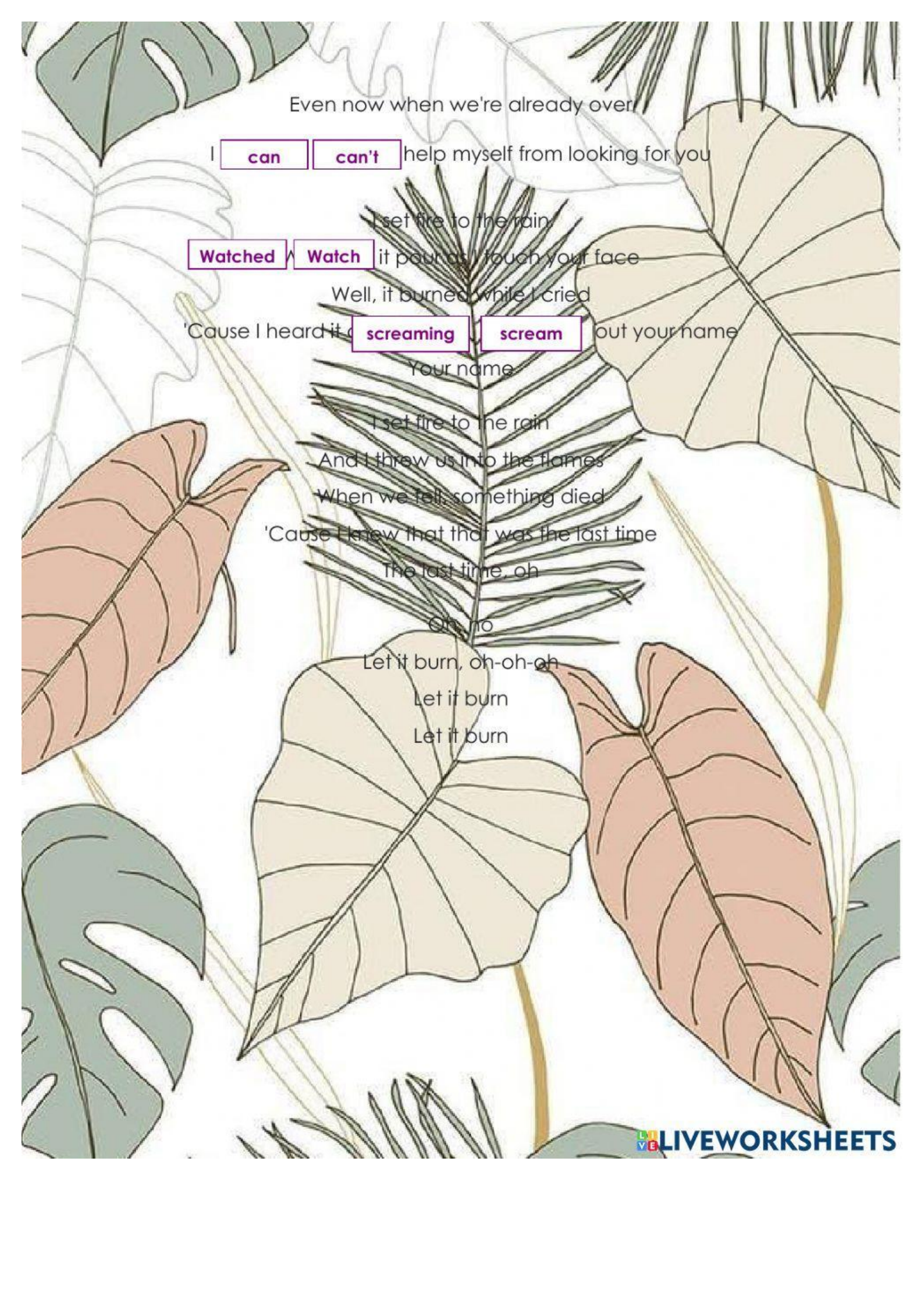
