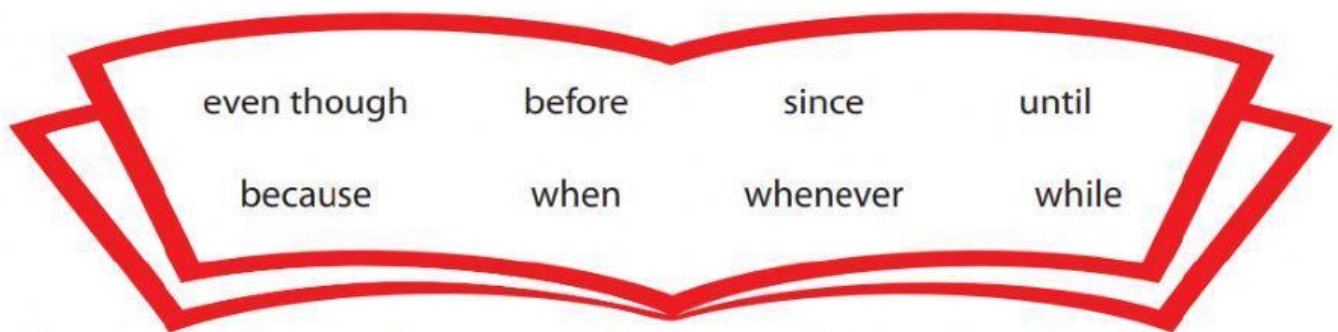


# Subordinating Conjunctions

A subordinating conjunction is a conjunction that introduces a dependent clause and joins it to the main clause.

Example: After Ken ate his dinner, he walked his dog.
