Remember

First Conditional

Structure

IF + Simple Present, Simple Future

(S + will/won't + V(bare form))

Usage

To talk about possibilities in the present
or in the future

Examples

- If it rains, I will stay at home.
- If I wake up late, I will miss the bus.
