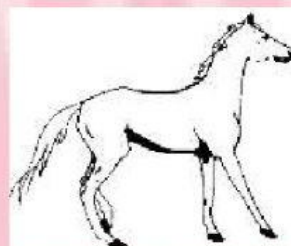
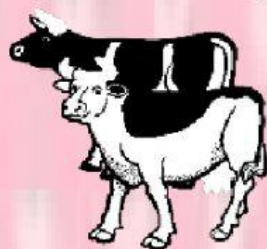
ENUMERATE THE NEEDS OF ANIMALS IN ORDER TO LIVE

This Learning Activity Sheet is about identifying the basic needs of animals and demonstrating ways of caring them. After going through LAS, you are expected to identify things that the animal body needs when growing up and how they survived.

ANIMALS AND THEIR NEEDS

Are there times when you feel hungry or thirsty? Just like people, animals also need food and water. They also need air and a place to live.

Animals differ in the kinds of food they eat. Some animals eat only plants. They are called **herbivores**. They usually have sharp and flat teeth for cutting, grinding, and mashing plants. Cows, rabbits, and goats are herbivores.



Examples of Herbivores

Some animals eat only other animals. They are called **carnivores**. Carnivores usually have sharp teeth for tearing flesh. Lions and snakes are carnivores. Look at some examples below of carnivorous animals.

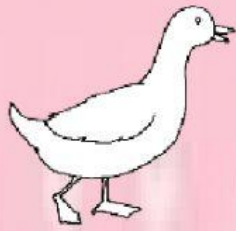

Some animals eat both plants and animals. They are called **omnivores**. Many kinds of birds are omnivores. They eat plant seeds and worms. Pigs are also omnivores. Some examples of omnivores below.

Some animals need to drink water. They use water to cool them down. For example, a carabao wallows in water to protect its skin from sunburn and have its body cool.

Animals need air. Have you noticed the bubbles in an aquarium? They come from an aquarium air pump. The pump is used to introduce oxygen into the aquarium water. Oxygen is the gas that people and animals need to stay alive.



Animals need shelter. A shelter protects animals from the rain and the heat of the sun. It also keeps them from being eaten by other animals.

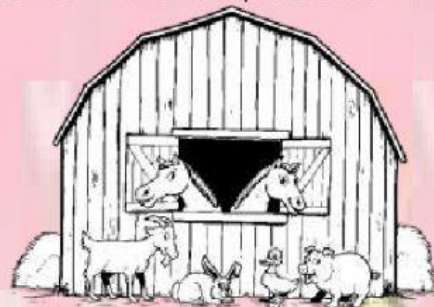
People provide shelter for their pets. Look at the examples below.



