

## MIXED CONDITIONALS

This means that the time in the if-clause is different from the time in the result.

Mixed conditionals help you to move through time.

A key idea is time but don't confuse time with verb tense.

Although we use tenses to express time, they are not always the same thing.

I **had** a dog when I was a child.

She **was cleaning** all day yesterday.

These sentences use different tense but both of them refer to the past.

There are ALL KIND of combinations but the most common is to mix the second and third conditionals:

2º conditional → If I **had** a lot of money, I **would buy** a big car. *Si yo tuviese mucho dinero, compraria un coche grande.*

3º conditional → If I **hadn't spent** all my money, I **would have bought** a big car. *Si no hubiese gastado todo mi dinero, habria comprado un coche grande.*

### MIX

If I **had** a lot of money, I **would have bought** a big car. *Si yo tuviese mucho dinero, habria comprado un coche grande.*

If I **hadn't spent** all my money, I **would buy** a big car. *Si no hubiese gastado todo mi dinero, compraria un coche grande.*
