Have a singular and plural form

Can use a singular verb or a plural verb

#### We can count

→ a tree two trees

The **book** <u>is</u> old. The **books** <u>are</u> old.

#### UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS

Have only one form (no plural)

Always use a singular verb

Cannot use a, an or a number before them

#### We cannot count

butter

utter butters

Sugar is sweet.

→ a rice a bread two rice two bread


