This is a good-news story about sea life. Scientists have reported that the numbers of blue whales in the eastern Pacific Ocean are the highest number in over a century. The University of Washington report that there are now over 2,200 blue whales between Mexico and Alaska. Hunters killed nearly all the blue whales in that area and were close to extinction. The local people weren't able to hunt whales from 1971 so the numbers of the world's largest mammal started increasing. It has taken over 40 years for the blue whale to recover. Dr Cole Monnahan - the lead scientist was very happy at this news. He said: "For us, this is a great conservation success story."

Dr Monnahan said: "Before this study, some people thought that we could expect to see the bigger number than 2,200 whales". Therefore, Monnahan warned that people had to protect these creatures. He reported: "California blue whales are recovering because we decided to stop catching them and made a better conservation. If we hadn't, the number of blue whales might reduce to near extinction." He added that: "The recovery of California blue whales from whaling shows the ability of blue whale inhabitants to rebuild under careful management and conservation."
