

Sources of Light Comparison Worksheet

In this assignment, you will be practicing using new vocabulary to identify objects that either are sources of light or receivers of light.

Here are some hints:

- Visible light is the only part of the electromagnetic spectrum that can be seen by humans.
- All visible light is made up of seven colors:
RED, ORANGE, YELLOW, GREEN, BLUE, INDIGO, VIOLET.
- Sources of light are called **luminous** objects – they give off their own light.
- Receivers of light are **illuminated** objects – they reflect or absorb light.

On your own paper make two columns and label them luminous and illuminated. Write all the objects that are luminous in the “luminous column” and all the objects that are illuminated in the “illuminated column”.
