- Always, usually, often, sometimes and never are frequency adverbs.
- Frequency adverbs tell how often things happen.
- Frequency adverbs come before the main verb:
subject + frequency adverb + verb

100% Always	I always study after class
90% Usually	I usually walk to work
80% Normally / Generally	I normally get good marks
70% Often / Frequently	I often read in bed at night
50% Sometimes	I sometimes sing in the shower
30% Occasionally	I occasionally go to bed late
10% Seldom	I seldom put salt on my food
5% Hardly ever / Rarely	I hardly ever get angry
0% Never	Vegetarians never eat meat

Subject + Adverb + Main Verb
Daniel always passes his exams.

Subject + BE + Adverb
He is always happy.
