### PRESENT SIMPLE

They **get up** at 5 o'clock.

No! We **don't get up** at 5, we **get up** at 8 o'clock in the evening.



#### Affirmative form

I get up...  
You get up...  
He/She/It gets up...  
We get up...  
You get up...  
They get up...

#### Negative form

I don't get up...  
You don't get up...  
He/She/It doesn't get up...  
We don't get up...  
You don't get up...  
They don't get up...

| Interrogative form        | Affirmative short answer | Negative short answer  |
|---------------------------|--------------------------|------------------------|
| Do I get up...?           | Yes, I do.               | No, I don't.           |
| Do you get up...?         | Yes, you do.             | No, you don't.         |
| Does he/she/it get up...? | Yes, he/she/it does.     | No, he/she/it doesn't. |
| Do we get up...?          | Yes, we do.              | No, we don't.          |
| Do you get up...?         | Yes, you do.             | No, you don't.         |
| Do they get up...?        | Yes, they do.            | No, they don't.        |
