They **get up** at 5 o'clock.



No! We **don't get up** at 5, we **get up** at 8 o'clock in the evening.

Affirmative form	Negative form
I get up...	I don't get up...
You get up...	You don't get up...
He/She/It gets up...	He/She/It doesn't get up...
We get up...	We don't get up...
You get up...	You don't get up...
They get up...	They don't get up...

Interrogative form	Affirmative short answer	Negative short answer
Do I get up...?	Yes, I do.	No, I don't.
Do you get up...?	Yes, you do.	No, you don't.

Do we get up...?	Yes, we do.	No, we don't.
Do you get up...?	Yes, you do.	No, you don't.
Do they get up...?	Yes, they do.	No, they don't.
