**TALLER**

If I ..... reach the shelf.

9. But for Helen acting so wonderfully, the play would be a flop.

**WONDERFUL**

If it ..... the play would be a flop.

10. It won't make any difference if City score first; United will still win.

**EVEN**

United ..... City score first.
