Wildfoods festival

If you're into weird food, don't miss the Hokitika Wildfoods Festival in New Zealand. It is a local festival which takes place annually in mid-March. I was there this year and it was one of the most unusual food festivals I've ever been to. There were over fifty stalls where you could buy all sorts of weird meals and snacks. All this 'wild food' is produced, picked or grown locally. I tried goat-milk ice cream (yuk!) and fried grasshoppers (yummy!). One stall was selling scorpions (both roasted and raw), which I also tasted. That was quite an experience! The Startled Worm Café attracted a lot of visitors with its menu of Worm Truffles and Worm Sushi. But most people were just curious. I didn't see many people eating the worms! Hokitika is by the sea, so if you're not brave enough to try insects, worms and larvae, there's plenty of delicious fresh fish and seafood. There is also lots of traditional-looking fast food including things like sausages, sandwiches and pizzas, but beware – the ingredients may surprise you! There were a few stalls which sold food that was suitable for vegetarians, but hardly any which were vegan. Of course, because it is a 'festival' there were lots of other activities, including live music, cooking demonstrations and a fashion competition where participants created costumes made of wood, plants and flowers. There was also a great street market where you could buy all sorts of regional herbs and spices as well as local arts and crafts. Hokitika Wildfoods Festival is an amazing experience and a lot of fun. Overall, I would recommend it for adventurous people who want to try something new. But if you're a vegan or vegetarian, I'd choose another destination!
