5. _____ A good deal of them have been displayed at international exhibitions in the USA, Canada, France, Germany and other countries. Contracts were signed with foreign trade companies.

Exhibits which reveal the factory's history dating back to 1802 are stored in the local historical museum of porcelain.

To the great regret, production ceased in 2010. In May 2012, the plant had debt of 1.9 million UAH. The plant was finally discontinued in 2013.
