



TIME	IF CLAUSE	RESULT CLAUSE
<b>Present + past</b>	Simple past	Would + have + V(p.p)
<b>Present + future</b>	Simple past	Would + V(inf.)
<b>Future + past</b>	Were – ing	Would + have + V(p.p)
<b>Future + present</b>	Were – ing	Would be + V (inf.)
<b>Past + present</b>	Past perfect	Would + V (inf.)
<b>Past + Future</b>	Past Perfect	Would + V (inf.)

But, Nicole (speak, not) \_\_\_\_\_ Chinese fluently if she (live, not) \_\_\_\_\_ in China for ten years.
8. I will not help you study for your test because you have spent the last two weeks partying and wasting time.  
But, I (help) \_\_\_\_\_ you study for your test if you (spend, not) \_\_\_\_\_ the last two weeks partying and wasting time.
9. Eleanor and Ben are not going skiing with us this year because Eleanor has just had a baby.  
But, Eleanor and Ben (go) \_\_\_\_\_ skiing with us this year if Eleanor (have, not, just) \_\_\_\_\_ a baby.
10. I am completely exhausted, so I will not go with you to the cinema tonight.  
But, if I (be, not) \_\_\_\_\_ completely exhausted, I (go) \_\_\_\_\_ with you to the movies tonight.
