

Adding and Subtracting Mixed Numbers

Addition

$$3\frac{1}{2} + 1\frac{3}{4} =$$

$$1\frac{2}{3} + 2\frac{2}{5} =$$

$$2\frac{3}{4} + 2\frac{1}{8} =$$

Subtraction

$$3\frac{2}{3} - 2\frac{1}{4} =$$

$$6\frac{3}{4} - 3\frac{1}{2} =$$

$$4\frac{1}{2} - 1\frac{1}{3} =$$

Three buckets are partly filled with water.

Each bucket can hold 10 litres in total.
