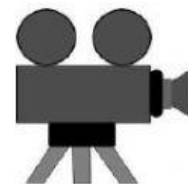

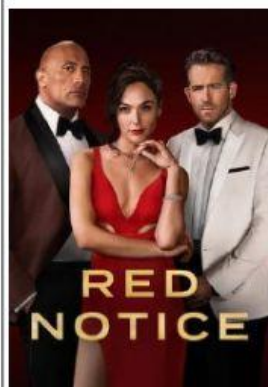

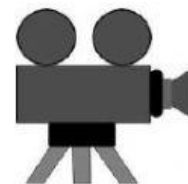

mining to mental health detriments.

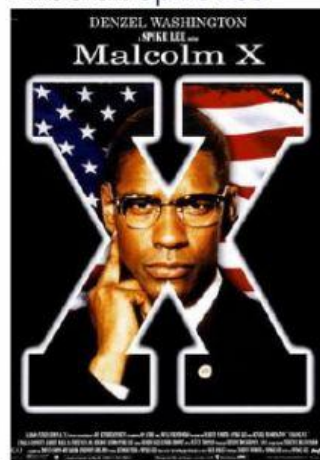
