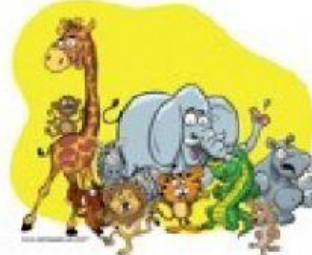


# METAPHORS
