Speech Marks or Inverted Commas

(Informally known as quotes and speech marks) are punctuation marks (" ") used in pairs to mark a section of text as speech, a quotation or a phrase.

Examples: "Let's go to Australia," Tiddalik said.

"This has been an unforgettable adventure!" exclaimed the eel.

Writers put **dialogue** in stories to make stories more real. The dialogue is always in speech marks (" ") so that the readers know that these are the words the character has said.
