

it **is** playing  
we **are** playing  
you **are** playing  
they **are** playing

### Short forms

I'm playing  
you're playing  
he's playing  
she's playing  
it's playing  
we're playing  
you're playing  
they're playing

he isn't playing  
she isn't playing  
it isn't playing  
we aren't playing  
you aren't playing  
they aren't playing
