1 Once upon a time, there was a boy called Josh. He lived in Canada with his stepfather and his two stepsisters.



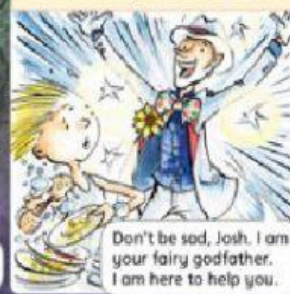
2 Josh dreamed of winning marathons. But on the day of the marathon in his town, his stepsisters took his running shoes.



3 Josh was very unhappy.



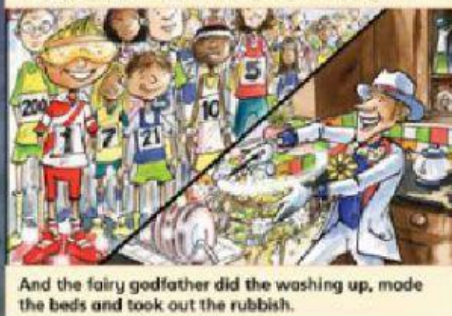
4 Then suddenly there was a flash!
