1 Mosa, Abri, John and Baruti are on a school trip to Victoria Falls.



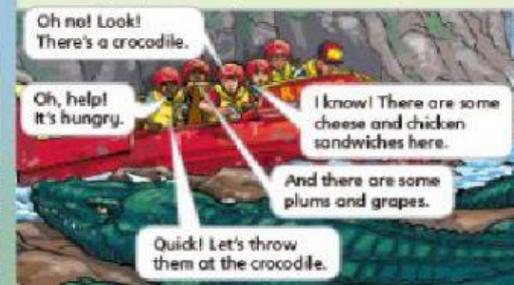
2 The children get into the jetboat. At first they go slowly down the river towards Victoria Falls.



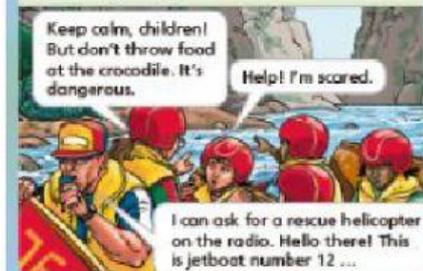
3 Suddenly the jetboat's engine makes a loud noise and goes faster. It speeds up the rapids towards the waterfall.
