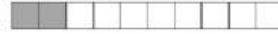


Model 1 and Model 2 have each been shaded to represent a decimal.

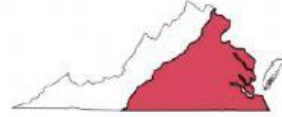
