It often rains / snows in autumn. Часто дощить / йде сніг восени.
It never rains / snows there. Там ніколи не дощить / не йде сніг.
It doesn't rain/snow in June. В червні не йде дощ / сніг.
Does it often rain/snow there? Там часто йде дощ / сніг?

Present Continuous

It is raining / snowing now. Зараз йде дощ / сніг.
It isn't raining / snowing now. Зараз не йде дощ / сніг.
Is it raining / snowing now? Зараз йде дощ / сніг?

- 1) The sun is shining now.

- 2) The wind is blowing in Rome now.

Past Simple

It often **rained** / **snowed** last winter.

Минулої зими часто йшов дощ / сніг.

It **didn't rain** / **snow** last month.

Минулого місяця не йшов дощ / сніг.

Did it **rain** / **snow** in March? В березні йшов дощ / сніг?
