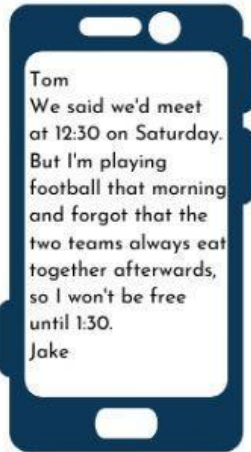

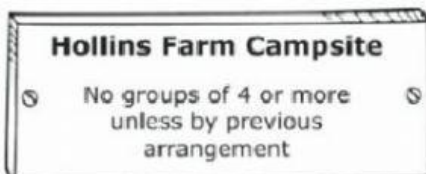

Read these short texts. For each question, choose the correct answer.

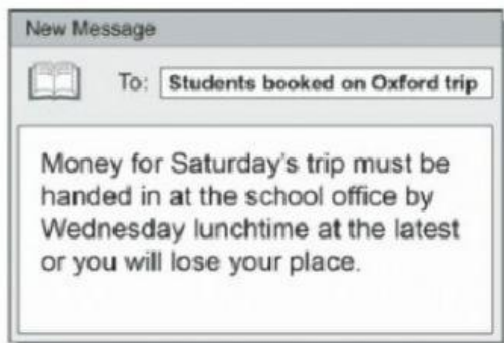


What is Jake doing in this message?

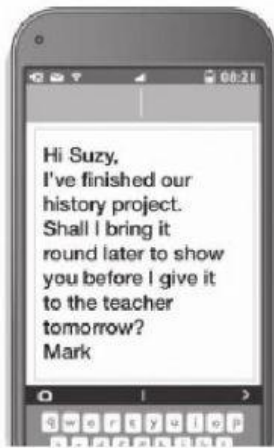

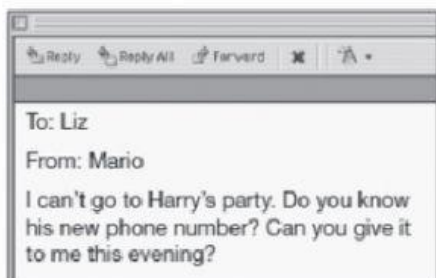
