

ANGEL FALLS

Angel Falls is located in southeast Venezuela in Canaima National Park. It's the tallest waterfall in the world. It's 62 meters (about 200 ft.) taller than the Burj Khalifa in Dubai and almost twice as tall as the Shanghai World Financial Center in China. A column of water falls almost 980 meters (3,200 ft.) from the top of the mountain to its base. Not all of the water reaches the base of the canyon. Some of it blows away into a fine mist.
