

## **PAY ATTENTION** TO THE FORMATION OF THE FOLLOWING VERB TENSES:

1 - PRESENT PERFECT = **HAVE/HAS + Past Participle**

Example: I **have worked** / She **has broken**

2 - PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS = **HAVE/HAS BEEN + ING**

Example: I **have been studying** / She **has been playing**

3 - FUTURE PERFECT = **WILL HAVE + Past Participle**

Example: I **will have worked** / She **will have broken**
