We form the regular past simple by adding **-ed** to the verb.

cancel → cancelled

play → played

cry → cried*

share → shared

help → helped

stop → stopped**

move → moved

wait → waited

need → needed

watch → watched

*change "y" to "i" and add -ed

**c-v-c = consonant-vowel-consonant, double the second consonant
