The \_\_\_\_\_ of sleep each person needs depends on \_\_\_\_\_ factors (*nhân tố*), including age. Babies generally require about 16 hours a day. For most adults, seven to eight hours a night appears to be the ideal (*lý tưởng*) \_\_\_\_\_ of sleep, although a \_\_\_\_\_ people may need as \_\_\_\_\_ as five hours' sleep or as \_\_\_\_\_ as ten hours' sleep each day. Getting too \_\_\_\_\_ sleep creates a sleep debt, and eventually, your body will demand that the debt be repaid.

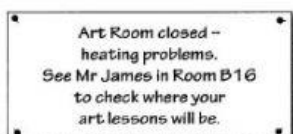

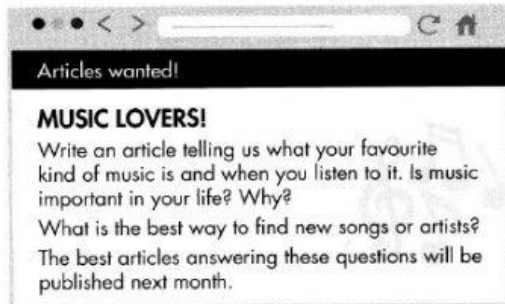
