



Future simple		
Affirmative	Negative	Question
I will work.	I will not work.	Will I work?
You will listen.	You will not listen.	Will you listen?
He/she will stay.	He/she will not stay.	Will he/she stay?
You will phone.	You will not phone.	Will you phone?
They will speak.	They will not speak.	Will they speak?

FUTURE SIMPLE WILL



will: prediction

We use **will** to talk about a future event, something that we think or predict will happen. We usually use the contraction **won't** (**will not**) for a negative prediction. After **will** / **won't** we use the infinitive without **to**.

Will for prediction (affirmative and negative)		
I / You / He / She We / They	✓ will ✗ won't	be successful. live in a flat. enjoy your job.

The first future tense is the future with "will." Use the future with will to talk about an event in the future that you have just decided to do, for predictions and for promises.

Remember

Use the future with will to talk about an event in the future that you have just decided to do, for predictions and for promises.

Curious fact...

Use "will" to make predictions or state facts about the future. Predictions are things that you will will (or won't) happen in the future. You can predict that "it will not rain tomorrow" or that "the world will end in a week."
