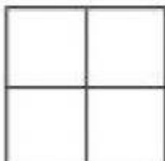


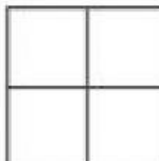
Multiplying Fractions by Wholes

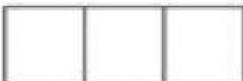
Example:

$$\frac{1}{3} \times 2 = \frac{2}{3}$$



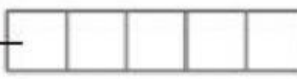

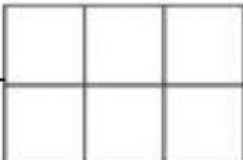

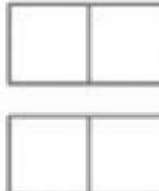
