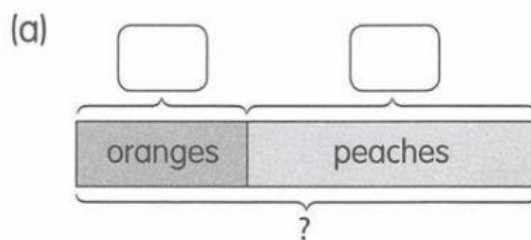

Practice 1 Two-Step Word Problems

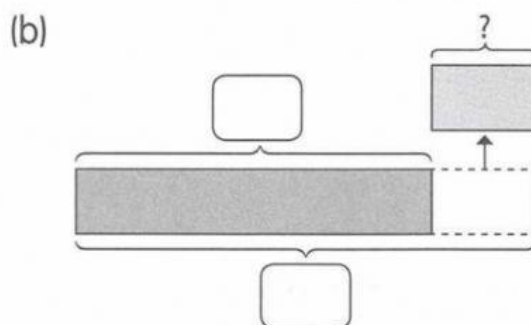
Solve.

(b) How many boxes of peaches did Uncle Sayid sell?

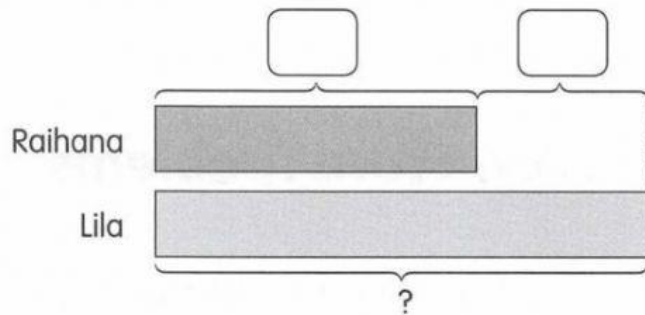

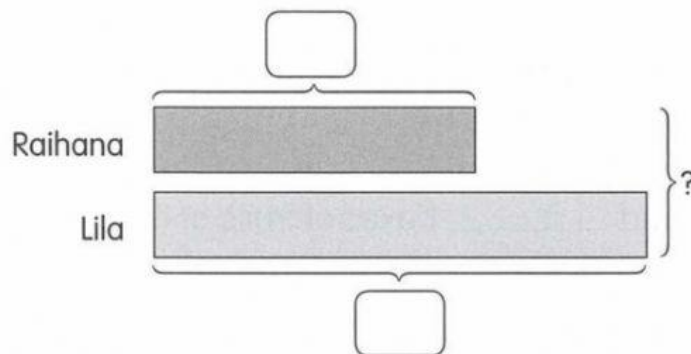


Uncle Sayid sold _____ boxes of peaches.
