## COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

We use comparative adjectives to show change or make comparisons.

► We usually add **-er** to one-syllable adjectives.



young	→ younger
cold	→ colder
short	→ shorter
small	→ smaller

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## COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

► We use **more** to make comparatives for most two syllable adjectives and for all adjectives with three or more syllables.



hardworking

more hardworking

generous	→ more generous
beautiful	→ more beautiful
punctual	→ more punctual
stubborn	→ more stubborn
selfish	→ more selfish
honest	→ more honest

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## COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

► Some one-syllable adjectives have irregular comparative forms.



bad



worse

good	→ better
far	→ farther/further
little	→ less

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## COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

► If an adjective ends in a consonant and **-y**, we change **-y** to **-i** and add **-er**.



happy

happier

dirty	→ dirtier
easy	→ easier
noisy	→ noisier
angry	→ angrier

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## COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

► We double the final letter of a one-syllable adjective ending in **consonant + vowel + consonant** and we add **-er**.



fat

fatter

big	→ bigger
sad	→ sadder
slim	→ slimmer
thin	→ thinner

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## COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

► With some two-syllable adjectives, we can either add **-er/-r** or use **more**.



handsome

handsomer

more handsome

polite	→ politer/more polite
simple	→ simpler/more simple
clever	→ cleverer/more clever
quiet	→ quieter/more quiet
narrow	→ narrower/more narrow
friendly	→ friendlier/more friendly
