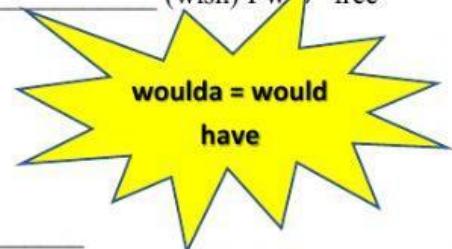


# IF IT HADN'T BEEN FOR LOVE
