Future Tense / be going to

1. Look at the statistics, the young more time on their phones in the future.(spend)
 2. Everybody we need more money soon.(know)
 3. It is planned his goal to raise money for the poor.(be)

Future Perfect Tense

1. The young ...**will have spent**... more time on their phones by 2030.(spend)
 2. Everybody ...**will have known**... we need more money by 2050.
 3. Our goal ...**will have been**... to raise money for the poor by then.(be)

Continuous Tenses**Present Continuous Tense**

1) Look! The young too much time on their phones.(spend)
 2) Now everybody we need more oxygen.(know)
 3) At present, our goal to raise money for the poor.(be)

Past Continuous Tense

1. The young too much time watching TV at that time.(spend)
 2. Everybody we needed more money this time last year.(know)
 3. Our goal to raise money for the poor this time yesterday.(be)

Present Perfect Continuous Tense

1. The young too much time on their phones for hours.(spend)
 2. Everybody we need more money since 2010.(know)
 3. Our goal to raise money for the poor recently.(be)

Past Perfect Continuous Tense

1. The young **had been spending** too much time watching TV before 1990.
 2. Everybody ...**had known**... we needed more money by 2010.(know)
 3. Our goal**had been**... to raise money for the poor before last month.(be)

Future Continuous Tense

1. The young ...**will be spending**... more time on their phones at this time next year.(spend)
 2. Everybody ...**will know**... we need more money at this time next decade.(know)
 3. Our goal ...**will be**... to raise money for the poor at that time.(be)

Future Perfect Continuous Tense

1. The young ...**will have been spending**... more time on their phones by 2030.(spend)
 2. Everybody **will have known** we need more money by 2050.(know)
 3. Our goal **will have been**... to raise money for the poor by then.(be)
