The diagram below shows a part of the Tropical Rainforest.

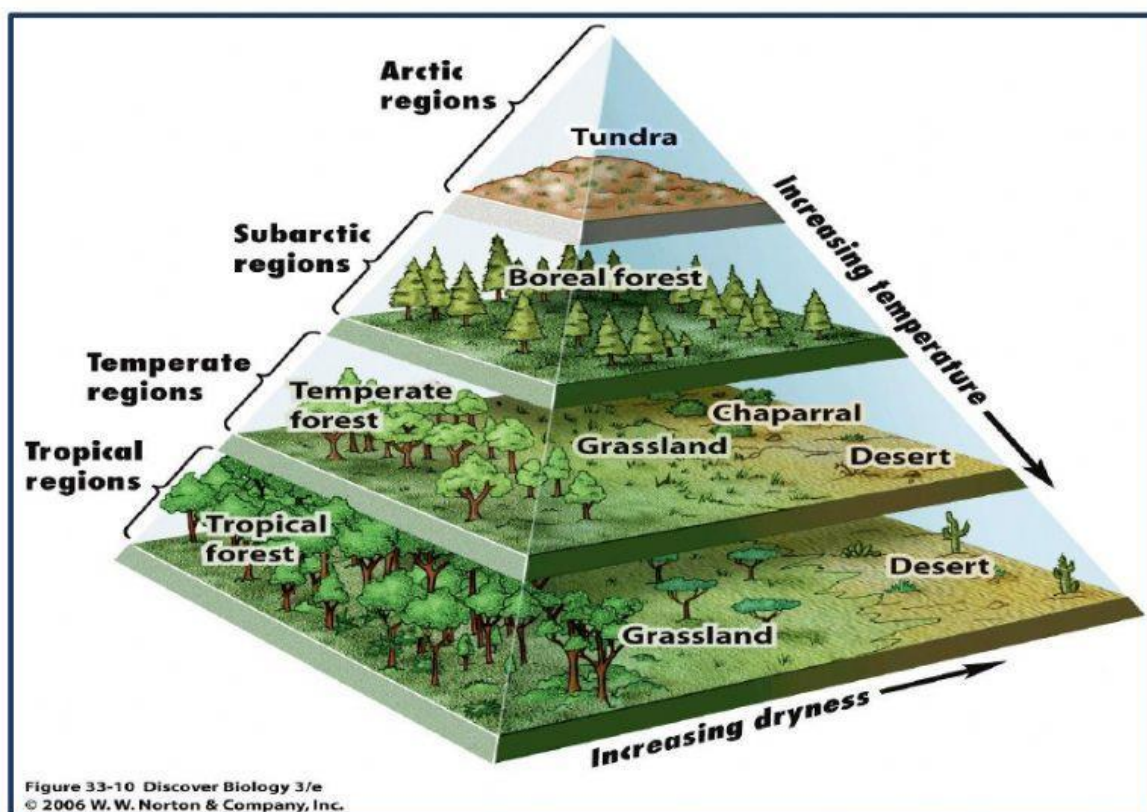
