

GOOD DEEDS, RIGHT THINGS

Aster's Good, Right Deeds are generally things she does to make other people feel good. They are also based on her belief that by doing good, right things she will be able to control her environment. This is a form of superstition as it is not based on reason or scientific knowledge but emotion and wishful thinking.

Choose 3 of the good, right things Aster does and explain how these helped the people around her. For example, in Chapter 12 Aster danced with Aunt Noni even though she doesn't dance. This meant that Aunt Noni had someone to dance with and it allowed Aunt Noni to think that Aster was feeling happy as people tend to dance when they are happy. Aunt Noni felt relieved that Aster was happy and this made Aunt Noni feel even happier. It also meant that Aunt Noni felt like Aster shared her joy of dancing rather than creating an awkward situation where Aunt Noni was dancing alone with Aster looking on.
