Everything has been eaten by them.

2. Someone has stolen my collection.

My collection has been stolen by someone.

3. My teacher has checked those exercises.

4. Her mother hasn't allowed her to go camping.

5. Our salesmen have sold all the carpets.

6. The zookeepers have captured the lion in the forest.

7. Dr. Phillips have treated all the patients.

Passive voice – Past Perfect

1. The brave men had defended the city.

The city had been defended by the brave men.

2. The little girl had broken the window.

The window had been broken by the little girl.

3. Those prisoners had robbed five banks.

4. Hospital staff had accepted the injured man.

5. The Americans had discovered another planet.

6. Firefighters had put out the fire successfully.

7. Jim had received an anonymous gift.
