TAG QUESTION

Positive statement → Negative tag question

Negative statement → Positive tag question

1. The question tag for: - I am is <i>aren't I?</i> - Let's is <i>shall we?</i> <i>(both positive and negative sentences)</i>	- I am your best friend, <i>aren't I?</i> - Let's sit over there, <i>shall we?</i> Let's not argue, <i>shall we?</i>
2. When the subject of the sentence is: - This/ That, we use <i>it</i> in the question tag. - These/ Those, we use <i>they</i> in the question tag. - Everybody, somebody, nobody..., we use <i>they</i> in the question tag. - Nothing/ everything, we use <i>it</i> in the question tag.	- That isn't your pen, <i>is it?</i> - Those are beautiful, <i>aren't they?</i> - Everyone must come, <i>mustn't they?</i> - Nothing is right, <i>isn't it?</i>
3. In the imperative , the question tag is <i>will you?</i>	- Give me the box, <i>will you?</i> - Don't forget to call me, <i>will you?</i>
