

Pronouns

Generic pronouns refer to people in general, including the speaker and the listener, without references to *specific genders*.

Questions:

- Is it referring to people in general? (use one/ones, you/your or we/us)
- Is it an opinion of a group of people? (use they say, they think, they believe etc)

We use 'it' to talk about **time, weather, distance, and some nouns: a pity, a shame, a love, a desire, an experience etc**

'It' is also used before an **adjective or an action verb.**

'**There**' + **to be** is used to say that something exists (or doesn't) or is present (or not). 'It' is also used before a **concrete noun: cathedral, money, rain, mountain,**

- Is there an adjective or an action verb?
- Is there a reference (direct or indirect) to **time, weather or distance**?
- Is there something that exists or doesn't exist?
