Has a tail.

□ Comet □

Some people
collect them.

Has an irregular
(not round) shape.

□ Meteor □

A rocky object that
orbits the sun.

Gets pulled into the
Earth's atmosphere
by Earth's gravity.

□ Meteoroid □

Sometimes called a
"shooting star"

Made of ice and
dust.

□ Meteorite □

Smaller than an
asteroid, but can be
as small as a speck
of dust.
