

Phrasal verbs (Education)

To add up (to): додавати, розуміти

- I added him up to at a glance.
- Every time I add these figures up I get a different answer.

to brush up on: освіжити (знання), повторити

- I am going to China soon I must brush up on my Chinese.

to catch up: наверстти, нагнати. Зверніть увагу, що catch up with має значення “нагнати когось, хто попереду”, а catch up on використовується в контексті “наверстти”, заповнити пробіли.

- She had to study hard to catch up with her classmates.
- I was sick all week, so now I have a lot to catch up on.

to cram: збурити, вивчити велику кількість матеріалу за короткий проміжок часу

- Elena just crams the night before exams. She doesn't study during the semester!
- I'll be in trouble if I don't stay up all night to cram for the examination.

to drop out: буквально - “випасти”. В контексті навчального закладу - кинути

- She dropped out of school.

to drum in (into): завчити, вбивати в голову

- I drummed in all new words.

to dumb down: спростити, зробити зрозумілим навіть для дурнів

- A teacher dumbed new material down that we all added it up.

to fall behind: відставати

- You're falling behind again. What have you been doing all month?

to find out: вияснити, дізнатись

to go over: повторити, передивитись, перевірити знов, перечитати

- We are meeting up with friends on Sunday to go over our lecture notes
- Could you go over this report and correct any mistakes?
- Tom's going to help me go over my monologue for the play.

to hand in/ to turn in: здавати (завдання, курсову)

- I have to hand in my essay by 5pm.

to hand out: роздавати

- The teacher opened a folder she'd brought with her and handed out sheets of paper to everyone.

to look at: прочитати бігло, перевірити, обдумати, розглянути

- I looked at your report and I think it's really good.
- Travel expenses are getting out of control. We need to have a look at them closely.

to look up: шукати інформацію в кни�ах, Інтернеті

- Can you give me his last name, so I can look up his email address?

to miss out: упускати, пропустити

- She missed some important points out of her essay.

to mix up: плутати

- Jack has difficulty with visualising numbers and often mixes them up.

to opt for: обирати

- Peter was unsure what to study in college, he eventually opted for business and law.

to pull an all-nighter: вчитись (працювати, писати) всю ніч

- I almost fell asleep during the test after an all-nighter
- I prefer to pull all-nighters. I think they are quite effective if you do it right.

to put off: відкласти

- Stop putting off finding a job!
- Don't put off the work till tomorrow.

to run through: переглядати, прокручувати

- I had run through my figures over and over again.

to sign up: підписатись, погодитись, приєднатись

to study under: навчатись під керівництвом

- He entered the Art Students' League where he studied under many famous artists.

to skive off: халтурити, байдикувати, не ходити на роботу, школу (необхідність)

- I had to skive off work as I was ill.

to take in: поглинати факти, інформацію, зрозуміти, розібратись

- I was so shocked that I didn't take in everything.
