

Producers, consumers and decomposers

Producers

Every food chain begins with a producer. Plants are producers. **They make their own food.**





Consumers

Living things that hunt, gather, and eat their food are called consumers. Consumers eat to gain energy. There are three types of consumers: primary, secondary, and tertiary.

Decomposers

They break down dead plants and animals. They put nutrients back into the soil.
